Application for Education Funding

Your application for Educational Funding must be accompanied by the relevant documents depending on the level of qualification for which you intend studying. If your bid is for funds under £350, complete the form but you need only provide one reference. Only one application may be made per year for the same funding project. Courses over a two- or three-year period may be granted the same figure, (at the discretion of the Trustees), in years two and three provided the course continues.

Hobbies, eg. Pastimes, Leisure Pursuits

Achievements, eg. Duke of Edinburgh Awards, Scouts, Guides.
